## GET READY FOR THE 2017 GENERAL ELECTION

To make it as easy as possible to vote in the general election, make sure that you are correctly enrolled now.

Only those who are enrolled can vote in the general election.

**You must enrol if you:**

- Are 18 years or older, and
- Are a New Zealand citizen or a permanent resident of New Zealand,
- And have lived in New Zealand for more than one year continuously at some time in your life.

For the purposes of enrolling to vote, a permanent resident is someone who does not have to leave New Zealand by a set date.

You need to update your enrolment details whenever you move house or change your name.

**Election Day is Saturday 23rd September 2017**

## SUNNYNOOK PARK STORMWATER UPGRADE

Auckland Council will create more flood storage in Sunnynook Park due to identified flood risks. The sports field surface will also be upgraded to sand carpet fields to increase sports field availability especially in winter.

### This project aims to:

- Improve drainage
- Widen shared cycleway and pedestrian access
- Upgrade the debris screen at the stream
- Improve the flood wall on Sycamore Drive



### Timeframe and access:

Works will start in October 2017 and it is anticipated site works will be completed by March 2019. Noise and vibration will be kept within regulations.

There may be some traffic delays but will be minimised. Access along Sunnynook Road and around the community centre will be limited. There will still be access through the park.

The northern portion of the main carpark will be temporarily closed off for use by construction personnel. Use of the sports fields will be limited until the sand carpet surface is finished.
